#### **RASAMRUT PHARMACY (DEPARTMENT OF AYURVED PHARMACY) :**

In the current year, different medicinal formulations were prepared along with job work etc. Total 482 medicinal formulations were prepared in the Rasamrut Pharmacy 3% increase is found in the medicine dispensing department. There is no price increase in MRP since last three years, as compared to last year purchase of raw material, packing material, etc whose price is comparatively increased. Ready-made medicines are purchased from the market and there is 17% increase in it.

In the current year approvals from FDA, Pune, Renewal of the GMP certificate is proposed.

From April 2022 to March 2023, the total sale of the medicines is 1,37,49,062. The amount required for raw material, purchase and packing material was 42,98,828. There is increase in 16.82% of the total purchase value which includes raw material, packing material, electricity bill, gas, stationary, transportation and machinery. Medicine dispensing is done in SGAK medicine, store, Bhimashankar Project, PARAS, special OPD Maharashtra Arogya Mandal, College and sample distribution in the current year 1,37,49,062 amount was received as compared to last year 2.97 % increase is seen.

- Opening was done by Dr. Lina Deshpande, CSR head, Bharat Forge Ltd, Pune. With the help of this clinic, the villagers are diagnosed quickly and health facilities are improved.
- From 1<sup>st</sup> August 2022 to 31<sup>st</sup> March 2023 31,210 patients have been benefited with the required medication, with the help of this telemedicine unit. Various online training workshops were received and villagers and patients were guided regarding the same.
- Total trainings conducted – 34, 169 villagers benefited.
- Doorstep health services, Hyderabad, Dr Niloufer and other dignitaries visited the Centre.

#### SOLAR PROJECT:

- Two Solar projects for drinking water or functioning. In this village 10.7 KW power solar at Pirachiwadi and 8 KW power at Kumbadwadi. For the protection of the solar panels compounds are being constructed and this project is functioning very well. The project was inaugurated by Dr. Lina Deshpande, Mr. Arun Gujar and Mr. Sagar Mitkari. Other dignitaries were present at the function. This project is developed with the concept of Green Village with a view that the villagers might get electricity and safe water supply.
- Solar project at Zila parishad school, Numberwadi, 5KW Power Solar Panel, van inverter and four batteries were fitted in school premises wiring work was done.
- Fruit plantation was done at Mauje Thakarwadi 33villagers were benefited with 400 mango saplings.
- Land levelling was done under the village development process, Mauje, Thakarwadi.
- Sheep shed was constructed in November 2022. 18 villagers were benefited in this project.

#### KALEWADI- KOTAMDARA DEVELOPMENT PROJECT:

- During the annual report period, watering of plants, cleaning of the grass around the trees, building tree guards was done. Out of 250 tree plantations, 214 trees survived in Kolwadi - Thakarwadi. In Kotamdara 55 trees survived out of 100 tree plantations.
- Land levelling was done at the farms of 99 farmers. Total 1187.72 guntha land was levelled. After the survey report, the beneficiaries were provided with potatoes, soyabean, tomato, groundnut, shalu, maize like crops and according to the market value it was Rs. 6,98,200.
- 38 farmer beneficiaries received 550 mango saplings.
- Sheep and goat shed was built for 13 beneficiaries.

#### MAUJE FADALEWADI UGALEWADI:

- Telemedicine clinic was established in this village as the villagers had to go to Ghodegaon and Shinoli to receive the medical treatments. With the help of this telemedicine video calling, many villagers were benefited, especially the geriatric and paediatric patients. During the report period that is 1<sup>st</sup> April 2022 to 31<sup>st</sup> March 2023 32,175 patients received proper medical care. In collaboration with the DOORSTEP INSTITUTION, various trainings and workshops were organised for the villagers. Information was provided regarding physical exercises and medications.
- On the successful completion of one year, celebrations were done at the telemedicine clinic with cake cutting in which dignitaries participated. Various activities like vaccination for 0 to 5 age group, children was conducted. 28 students participated actively in competitions like painting, also various games were organised.
- After the survey report, land levelling was done for 200.25 gunthas. 16 farmers were benefited. Soyabean, groundnuts were cultivated by these farmers in which they were profited with Rs. 65,000.
- Fruit cultivation, 25 beneficiaries received 525 mango saplings.

#### MAUJE GANGAPUR:

- Road widening was done. Trees were planted alongside the road. Trees were watered, grass removed and tree gaurds was built around it. Out of 200 trees planted 115 trees survived.





- 2021 Guntas land of 100 farmers was levelled and the farmers were able to cultivate soya bean rice, shalu, etc on their land and Rs. 9,47,000 amount of market value was produced from this land.
- 117 beneficiaries received 1475 mango saplings.

#### MAUJE CHIKHLI:

- Trees were planted after road widening. Grass was removed around trees, tree guard established and they were watered regularly. Out of 100 trees plant 100 have survived.
- Telemedicine  
With help of online doctor facility available at the telemedicine clinic from 1<sup>st</sup> April 2022 to 31<sup>st</sup> March 2023, 1431 patients were benefited and received appropriate treatments and medicines. Various trainings and workshops were conducted. Many activities were conducted with the help of doorstep institution Dr. Suchita Mankar and Dr. Paradkar actively participated.
- 280.30 gunthas land was levelled and made cultivable. 30 farmers were benefited with this project rice, shalu, groundnuts were cultivated after this and as per the market value Rs. 1, 22,500 amounts was received after selling of the products.
- 45 farmer beneficiaries were distributed, 970 mango saplings for cultivation.

#### MAUJE CHAPTEWADI:

- Land levelling was done for 40 farmers in which totally 655 gunthas land was made cultivable. After survey report, soya bean, rice, groundnuts were cultivated and as per the market value the farmers received amount of 1, 86,250.

#### MAUJE PHULEWADI:

- Up till now 80 farmers have done their land levelling. Approximately 1159 gunthas land has been made. Cultivable hear the beneficiaries have cultivated Soya bean, rice, groundnuts and they have received amount of 3, 31,200 as per the market value.
- 53 farmer beneficiaries received 1250 mango saplings for cultivation.

#### MAUJE VADGAON KASHIMBEG:

- Two-lane road was developed and tree cultivation was done alongside the road. All the villagers, dignitaries from Maharashtra Arogya Mandal, 40 employees of Bharat Forge were present along with students from the village. 145 trees were planted along with tree guard. Installation remaining 105 trees were planted in the open grounds where the trees are essential.
- Tree cultivation is done on social grounds in which 1500 feet long compound made up of thorns was constructed to protect 250 trees planted during this time for the security of the trees. Cleaning, grass removal, watering of the plants was done by the villagers, 500 trees were planted in this area.
- In Valunjwadi village 55 farmer beneficiaries received 580 mango saplings.

#### MAUJE NANVADE-TIRPAD:

- Land levelling was done of 440.32 gunthas and the soil was made cultivable with this majorly rice was cultivated by 44 beneficiary farmers. They received amount of Rs.2,71,675 as per market value.

#### MAUJE NIGHOTWADI-DUSTARWADI:

- Under the finish development project 3 beneficiaries received sheep and goat shed.

#### MAUJE AMONDI:

- Tree plantation was done alongside the road out of 250 trees, 250 have survived.
- 39 students and teachers of SSAM did tree plantation. The villagers took care of watering the trees removing the grass. Out of 500 trees planted 460 plants have survived.





- Tree plantation on social grounds was done out of 230 plants, 150 keshari mango saplings and other 80 were planted. School students from the village and teachers, villagers participated in plantation.
- 596.15 gunthas of land was levelled and made cultivable for 42 in which Soya bean, rice, groundnuts were cultivated. As per market value the farmers were profited with amount of 4,95,550.
- Fruit plantations - total 112 farmer beneficiaries were provided with 2750 mango saplings and 150 other saplings for cultivation.
- The lake was cleared and capacity for water storage was increased with the help of JCB, Pocklan, in April 2022, with help of this activity, water storage capacity was increased from 17TCM to 43TCM. 300 families of the village are benefited with this activity, Dr. Ninad Deshpande CSR head Bharat Forge Ltd inaugurated and submitted this project to the villages.

#### MAUJE PINGALWADI:

- Land levelling was done and made cultivable for 521.83 gunthas and 36 farmers were benefited. Soya bean, potato ground nuts were cultivated and received 1,64,750 amount as per the market price.
- 17 beneficiaries received 340 mango saplings for cultivation.

#### OTHER VILLAGE DEVELOPMENT PROJECTS:

- At Mauje Amondi lake cleaning was done and Kotamdara (Brahmanwadi) drinking water tank was established and presented to the villagers by Bharat Forge and Maharashtra Aarogya Mandal.
- There was a meeting held at Dyanada Training Centre village development Project, Dimbhe in which Dr. Lina Deshpande, CSR head Bharat Forge Ltd, Pune, Mr Anil Gujar Secretary MAM and Mr. Sagar Mitkari and many other dignitaries attended and discussed on various points like Green Village Development, nutritious food for school going students, proper use of solar energy.
- Mauje Thakarwadi (Chas) village Forest Conservation Authority, Forest Department, Junnar attended the meeting in which trees cultivation in the open lands idea was put forth by the dignitaries.
- Dr. Lina Deshpande took a meeting under village development project at Mukhtangan Vastigruha, Narodi. All the dignitaries were present to take various decisions on the progress and development of the village. There was a meeting conducted with Hon. Mr. Babasaheb Kalyani of Bharat Forge Limited in which, all the developments in the various villages were put forth and discussed.
- Online meeting was conducted regarding the village development in order to receive financial budget of the current year and the preceding year dignitaries from Bharat Forge, Maharashtra Arogya Mandal accounts officers were present.
- Har Ghar Tirangaa -On the occasion of 75th Independence Day from 13th 15 August 2022 this activity was conducted in the village, even Republic Day was celebrated in the similar way.
- 461 beneficiaries from 9 villages received 8840 mango saplings. In which geotag photos of the benefited farmers were clicked and were interviewed.
- Educational visit to Krishi Vignan Kendra, Baramati was conducted under village development project on 20 January 2023, in which 23 farmers from 12 villages, 8 employees from Maharashtra Arogya Mandal participated in this exhibition. There was a display on grounds of Netherland Technology for farming techniques, new seeds, inspection of the soil and its benefits. Various stalls displaying innovative insect control techniques, new machinery needed for farming, modern products and technologies in animal husbandry were put up and focused. Knowledge was gained by the farmers regarding plot development.
- Visit was made to these 12 villages to analyse the village development done in the said year and a budget was prepared for next year. Also various works, repairs need to be done were penned down.
- The institute has received donations from businessmen of Mumbai. They have also promised stationery is to be provided to the various schools like speakers bench, repairs, cupboards in schools.

#### OTHERS:

Dr. Dada Gujar Mother and Child Hospital inauguration was done by Hon. Dr. Mohanji Bhagwat RSS. During this function, Hon.Mr. Babasaheb Kalyani, Secretary and Founder of Bharat Forge Ltd and his wife Mrs. Sunita Kalyani, Hon. Mr. Anil Gujar Secretary, MAM graced the grand event.





- Under the village development project Dhimbe, on 6 July 2022, Krishi Vignan, Kendra, Baramati, Mr Joshi visited Wadgaon, Kashimbeg, Amondi and observed the road widening and tree cultivation. Total 670 trees are planted. The officials from the forest department came for inspection of the tree plantation done during this year. The forest division officers along with employees of Bharat Forge, Maharashtra Arogya Mandal did discussion regarding the tree plantation in the meeting.
- 23 July 2022, Zilla Parishad school new building at Vadgaon-Kashimbeg was inaugurated by Hon. Mr. Diliprao Valse Patil. All dignitaries were present for this function.
- During the annual report period, the motor at the river was provided with new electricity meter. Meter reading was connected to electricity department office, Manchar.
- For the 75th Independence Day celebrations, Har Ghar Tiranga was celebrated from 13 to 15 August and on the same day on the commemoration of Dr. Dada Gujar Sir birth anniversary function was organised.
- New English school, Gohe was provided with the essential in NMMS and scholarship books, after receiving it from Nivedita Madkikar Foundation, Pune.
- Maharashtra Arogya Mandal's Secretary, Hon. Mr Anil Gujar after reading Ranka brothers advertisement, Padarwadi Solar street light was asked with a request letter to Mr. Uday Singh Chaudhary. Positive response was received from their side.
- Smt. Kusumtai Karnik, institute's senior social service person passed away on 2 November 2022 due to old age. Her last rites were conducted at Mauje Aahupe.
- Generator servicing was done by Trident company on 11 February 2023
- Mr Uday Singh Chaudhari retired in May 2023. He has worked a lot in village development committee and Bachat Gat of various villages.
- International Institute for applied system analysis, Austria and Indian science education and research Centre, Pune along with SuperCom organised a workshop on 17 January 2023 regarding food, water and livestock resources.
- On 24 January 2023, the Nature Converses Institute, Pune organised a workshop on Gold River water fund stock return enjoyment.
- On 26 January 2023 flag hoisting was done in the office on occasion of the Republic Day.
- On 2 March 2023 on the occasion of Dr. Dada Gujar. Death anniversary a function was organised in Wagholi. In this function Mrs. Mangal Shah was awarded with best work is in social field where as health award was given to Pune Netra Seva Pratishthan.

### **MUKTANGAN ADIVASI GIRLS HOSTEL NARODI:**

**Academic:** Total 64 girl students are hostelling here.

5<sup>th</sup> Std - 7 students, 6<sup>th</sup> Std - 15 students, 7<sup>th</sup> Std - 5 students, 8<sup>th</sup> Std - 12 students, 9<sup>th</sup> Std - 10 students and 10<sup>th</sup> Std - 15 students.

From standard 5th to 9th annual examinations held at Mukta Devi School, Narodi, all students passed. Out of 15 students who appeared for the 10th examination all passed. 10 new students have been enrolled out of which 7 in 5<sup>th</sup> Std, 2 6<sup>th</sup> Std and 1 in 9<sup>th</sup> Std has been admitted in the hostel.

Extra classes arranged from 1 August 2022 for mathematics and English subjects.

The examinations held as per schedule. Students participated in various competitions like elocution. The 10<sup>th</sup> passed students were felicitated in the hostel. Parent teacher meeting was conducted in month of December in which their academic progress was discussed along with information regarding scholarship was given to the parents. There was a science exhibition held in the school on 23<sup>rd</sup> Jan 2023. 24 January 2023 Annual gathering was organised, all students participated actively.

Health check up camp was organised on 4<sup>th</sup> July 2022, doctors from PHC, Narodi did corona antigen test of 70 people, in which 7 girls were found positive. The students were sent home with their parents. Second dose of the Covid vaccination was given in July. Dr Gomti conducted health checkup





camp for 40 girls in August. Students haemoglobin and calcium test were also conducted in November and December. 15 girls were vaccinated for measles vaccine.

Solar system and inverters were repaired timely by Jaguar company.

Mr. Sarang visited the hostel with his family and gifted students fruits and stationery sets.

In August 2022, There was a workshop organised to train the girls students with the sewing machine so that the girls might prefer size them self with stitching and could take up tailoring as business.

On 29th and 30 April 2022, there was a workshop organised on honeybee cultivation.

9-11 Sept 2022 yoga training workshop organised for 50 girl students. Various asanas were taught.

On 2 February 2023, Dr Ramesh Lohani Sir, gave a lecture to the students on girl, health viral diseases, importance of healthy diet and give them information about Abha card.

There was a small trip organised on 6 November 2020 to Mauli Mandir Narodi.

Educational visit to Shivneri Fort, Lenyadri Ganapati and Ozar Ganapati.

Panchami festival and Raksha Bandhan was celebrated on 2 August 2022, in which cultural games were played by the girls students.

Flag hosting was done on 15 August 2022, and Dr Dada Gujar birth anniversary was celebrated.

26 Sept 2022, Navratri festival celebrated in which the girl students organised Dandia programme.

On 5<sup>th</sup> October girls celebrated Dussehra by doing Pooja of and books, farming instruments.

14 November was celebrated as children's day in the hostel.

Kranti Jyoti Savitribai Phule birth anniversary was celebrated on 3<sup>rd</sup> January in which 15 students spoke. On 4 January 2023, Sindhutai Sapkal Smriti celebrated and her biography movie was shown to the students.

Rajmata Jijau and Swami Vivekananda birth anniversary was celebrated on 12 January 2023.

On 19 February 2023, Shiv Jayanti was celebrated with great enthusiasm in which 25 girls students participated and put forth their views.

6 March 2023 Holi was celebrated by all and 22nd March Gudi Padwa was celebrated by placing Gudi in the hostel campus.

AMC, room repairs, inverter servicing, CCTV servicing, new solar light implementation was done aptly in the current year. Cleaning campus, planting of vegetables - spinach, brinjal, chillies was done.
