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
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MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

This Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) (this "Understanding") is executed on the day of the October month of 2020 by and between the

KAHEK's Shri B. M. Kankanawadi Ayurved Mahavidyalaya, a constituent unit of KLE Academy of Higher Education & Research, Deemed-to-be-University, Shahapur, Belagavi, Kamataka, 590003, represented by Registrar KLE Academy of Higher Education & Research Belagavi (here after referred as 'KAHER'S BMK', which expression shall, unless repugnant

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With

Maharashtra Arogya Mandal, Mahwadi, Hadpasar, Pune, Maharashtra (here in after referred to as "MAM" Represented by Mr Anil Gujar Secretary MAM which expression shall, unless repugnant to the subject or context thereof, be deemed to include and mean to its nominees, successors and permitted substitutes or assigns) on another PART,

Either or both of which may be referred to as a "Party" or the "Parties" respectively as the context demands.

WHERE AS

- A. The MAM and KAHER'S BMK desire to collaborate in the fields of Research, Ayurvedic Medical Education, Drug development & Standardization, Faculty & student exchange programs and community health care etc. for the mutual benefit by utilizing the expertise and infrastructure existing in both institutions.
- B. Based on the strengths of the MAM and KAHER'S BMK, the MAM is desirous of collaborating with KAHER'S BMK, which would provide education, research, faculty-student exchange, pharmacy related, clinical trials and academic programs.

MoU is to establish hereby a formal understanding of cooperation and friendship which is intended to have further the academic objectives of each institution and to promote better understanding between the faculty and students of MAM and the faculty and students of KAHER'S BMK.

BACKGROUND:

Maharashtra Ayurveda Mandal is a trust, registered under Bombay Public Trust Act with No. F-230 (Poona) and Societies Registration Act [80] with No. Bom/359/Pn, which is working in the fields of Health, Education and Tribal Development since 1960. MAM established Sumatibhai Shah Ayurved Mahavidyalaya in 1990. College is affiliated to MUHS, Nasik and recognized by CCIM for UG, PG, PhD and Diploma / Certificate courses. Sane Guruji Arogya Kendra is established in 1990, which is having 250 bed multispecialty hospital and got ISO 9601:2015 accreditation. Sane Guruji Hospital has been accredited by NA6H serving, 1.7 fac patients in OPD and, 13600 patients in IPD every year. Autonomous R & D Insutute PARAS is established as an Autonomous R&D Institute in 2015 to promote February healthcare services. MAM has got Center of Excellence from Ministry of AYUSH,

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Govt. of India for research in Mother and child care. MAM also has GMP certified Rasamrut Ayurveda pharmacy, Sickle Cell Community Healthcare Center, and works on Bhimashankar Tribal Development Project, Natural Resource Management etc. Institutes of MAM have good infrastructure for teaching and research with innovative staff.

KLE Academy of Higher Education & Research is declared as Deemed-to-be-University u/s 3 of the UGC Act, 1956 vide Government of India Notification No.F.9.19/2000-U.3 (A), Re-accredited (2nd cycle) as 'A' Grade by NAAC and placed in Category 'A' by MHRD (Gol). KLE Ayurveda Hospital & Medical Research Center has been accredited by NABH, the first Ayurvedic institute to get NABH accreditation in Karnataka. Shri BMK Ayurveda Mahavidyalaya is established in 1933 and is a constituent Institution of KAHER. It has been recognized by CCIM for 11 PG departments with 64 seats and 100 UG seats. It is also conducting PhD program in Ayurveda and Interdisciplinary areas, Fellowship Programs on Ayur-Oncology and Ayur-Cardiology and PG certificate programs on various domains like Vajeekarana, Ksharasutra, Panchakarma, Herbal Drug Research, Ayurgenomics etc. It has state of art infrastructure for teaching as well as research. Its Central Research facility has been approved as DTL for ASU drugs by AYUSH, Govt. of Karnataka. DAME has been recognized by CCIM as Regional Teacher Training center.

Under this Memorandum of Understanding, the two institutions will proceed to implement the following endeavors and exchanges of materials and personnel.

ARTICLE I: OBJECTIVE

The Parties, subject to the terms of this Memorandum of Understanding and the laws, rules, regulations and national policies from time to time in force, agree to strengthen, promote and develop co-operations in the field of Indian system of medicine (Ayurveda) and Inter Disciplinary Medicine between the two Institutions.

ARTICLE II: AREAS OF COOPERATION

Cooperation shall be carried out, subject to availability of funds and the approval of the competent authority of MAM and KAHER'S BMK, through such activities or programs as:

Exchange programs:

- o Faculty
- o PhD & PG scholars, Fellowship students
- UG Students

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Faculty and PhD, PG & UG students will be exchanged from both Institutes every year for different programs like Workshops, Guest lectures, short time training courses, Seminars, Webinars, short term research programs and project works etc. as agreed by both Institutes from time to time.

Utilization of research facilities, Joint Research activities

- Faculty and students of both Institutes will be allowed, with prior permission, to utilize the research facilities of the Institutes by paying prescribed nominal fee, if any. Both institutions will facilitate the students & faculty by providing access to facilities, guidance of concerned Faculty and Research staff.
- Both will promote and facilitate inter-institutional, interdisciplinary research and collaborative research projects by faculty and students of the institutions. Short term research projects, summer research projects etc. will be allowed.

Multi-centric studies

To provide evidence based clinical research Multi-center clinical studies will be taken up. Faculty of both Institutes will be allowed to apply and do projects on Collaborative multi-centric studies. Various laboratory facilities, expertise of faculty will be allowed for it.

Continuation of PG/PhD thesis activities

Students of both Institutes will be allowed to have extension of their dissertation/ thesis activities utilizing facilities and expertise in these institutions.

Online meetings/On line Guest lectures

Innovative methods, Information Communication & technology will be used to have better interaction among faculty and students of Institutes through Online guest lectures, group interactions through Skype etc. E-library resources will also be shared. Collaborative online courses on various platforms like SWAYAM, NPTEL will be undertaken.

Knowledge sharing

Both Institutes will share the knowledge through various academic activities, interaction of faculty, students, online discussions etc. They will allow partner Institution to utilize the databases, educational material, case presentations, practical manuals, dissertations etc.

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Curriculum development

- Both Institutes will work in this area of Curriculum development by organizing workshops, brain storming sessions, skill development programs, CME programs collaboratively. They will work to create better teaching methodology, evaluation methods, feedback methods, skill lab trainings, multimedia utilization in teaching, and simulated practical for Ayurveda.
- · Participation in seminars and academic developments
- Planning joint International Conferences and Workshops,
- · Planning research publications in the journals published by each Institute
- Implementation of joint educational programs in each Institute within the identified areas
- · Exchange of academic materials and other information
- The terms of such mutual cooperation and necessary budget for each specific program
 and activity that is implemented under the terms of this MoU. Each Institute will
 designate a Liaison Officer to develop and coordinate specific activities or programs.

Outreach Program:

Screening camps for Sickle Cell Anemia, COE related ANC programs will be conducted.

ARTICLE III: FINANCIAL ARRANGEMENTS

 The financial arrangements to cover expenses for the identified research activities undertaken within the framework of this Memorandum of Understanding shall be mutually agreed upon by both the Parties on a case-by-case basis subject to availability of funds. Collaborative funding proposals will be planned and executed with various govt/non govt. agencies.

ARTICLE IV: PROTECTION OF INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHTS

- (a) The protection of intellectual property rights shall be enforced in conformity with the national laws, rules and regulations.
- (b) Notwithstanding anything in paragraph (a) above, the intellectual property rights in respect of any technological development, and any products and services development, carried out:
- (i) Jointly by the parties or research results obtained through the joint activity effort by the Parties, shall be jointly owned by the Parties in accordance with the terms to be

- (ii) Solely and separately by the Party or the research results obtained through the sole and separate effort of the Party, shall be solely owned by the Party concerned.
- (iii) The terms and conditions in the execution of the research projects (Commercialization) shall be decided on case to case basis.

(iv) ARTICLE V : PATENT FILING

- a. KAHER and MAM shall have the first right to file a patent application on any joint inventions at joint expenditure and shall include as named inventors the staff and / or students from both the parties.
- b. Commercialization aspects can be mutually considered on case to case basis.

ARTICLE VI: CONFIDENTIALITY

- A. Each Party undertakes to observe the confidentiality and secrecy of documents, information and other data received from, or supplied to, the other Party during the period of the implementation of this Memorandum of Understanding or any other agreements made pursuant to this Memorandum of Understanding;
- B. Both Parties agree that the provisions of this Article shall continue to be binding between the Parties notwithstanding the termination of this Memorandum of Understanding.

ARTICLE VII: SETTLEMENT OF DISPUTES

Any difference or dispute between the Parties concerning the interpretation and/or implementation and/or application of any of the provision of this Memorandum of Understanding shall be settled amicably through mutual consultation and/or negotiation between the Parties. In case, the dispute occurred between both the parties and if the same is not resolved through negotiation or by adopting amicable measures, in that case the matter will be settled through Arbitration and the Arbitrator will be appointed with the mutual consent of both the parties.

ARTICLE VIII: ENTRY INTO FORCE, DURATION AND TERMINATION

This understanding shall come into force and take effect from the date first written above and shall be valid for a period of FIVE (5) YEARS and may be renewed thereafter by the parties upon mutual consent.

This understanding may be terminated by either party by providing 90 (ninety) days written notice to the other party before the beginning of academic year, and the termination would be effective at the end of the notice period. And the termination of the

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Understanding shall be on the understanding that students/ faculty who have already enrolled in any of the courses / research programs as at the time of termination shall remain entitled to complete their respective courses/ research programs and be eligible to appear assessment conducted by the MAM and KAHER'S BMK conduced to obtain an award. The obligation of the parties shall continue to be in force during such period, notwithstanding any termination of the Understanding.

The termination shall not be caused for any other reasons other than those enumerated in this MoU or for any other reasons such as force measure, change in law, government policies, epidemics etc.

Now this MOU Witnesses as follows the Roles and Responsibilities of Either Party

- a) Common Responsibilities
- Both institutes have to provide minimal accommodation for students/ faculty of other institute in their institute on nominal costs.
- Students/ faculty have to pay the prescribed fee for the facilities they have used.
- Universities have to facilitate for easy exchange programs and collaborative work.
 Administrative hurdles to be cleared at higher level by clear transparent methodology.
- Periodic meeting of co-ordinators should be arranged to have collaboration and cooperation among faculty of two universities.
- Both parties understand that all financial arrangements will have to be negotiated and will depend on the availability of funds.
- b) Roles & Responsibilities of KLE Academy of Higher Education & Research, Deemed to be University and Shri BMK Ayurveda Mahavidyalya, Belagavi and Maharashtra Ayurveda Mandals Institutes MAM
- MAM and KAHER'S BMK will facilitate for collaborative activities in teaching, education and research. Both will arrange facilities for conducting activities including in-house and visiting members from academic institutes.
- MAM and KAHER'S BMK shall also arrange to appoint a Coordinator who shall be
 available at the centre where the programs being offered, in order to facilitate proper
 coordination between the MAM and KAHER'S BMK covering all aspects relating to
 conduct of training, research and all other activities coming within the ambit of

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- All students will be governed by the academic regulation of respective parent institutions. i.e. MAM or KAHER'S BMK, as specific to the course or program offered, which shall be provided by the MAM or KAHER'S BMK to the students at the start of the course/ program.
- MAM and KAHER'S BMK shall maintain both in physical as well as in an electronic format (wherever possible or available) the details (including academic records) of all students/ faculty enrolled for the programs, and shall provide the same to MAM and KAHER'S BMK on request.
- KAHER'S BMK will allow to utilize its facilities for education, teaching and research
 collaboration, where in the MAM will allow the all facilities of the research available
 at PARAS and MAM. From both MAM and KAHER'S BMK faculty will provide
 guidance time to time.
- c) Miscellaneous:
- A coordination committee consisting of the following will monitor the academic and research programs and all related operational activities.
- Principal KAHER's BM K Ayurveda Mahavidyalaya, Belagavi of KLE Academy of Higher Education & Research, Deemed to be University
- 2. Secretary, Maharashtra Ayurveda Mandal, Hadaspar, Pune
- One Nominee of MAM- Member Dr Pranita Joshi Deshmukh (Research Coordinator PARAS, Asso. Prof. HOD RMMS Dept at SSAM)
- One nominee of KAHER Member Dr. Vendantam Giridhar, Reader, Department of Central Research Facility
- At MAM, the Research Coordinator, PARAS will oversee the implementation of the Memorandum of Understanding.
- At KAHER's BMK, Principal, Shri BMK Ayurveda Mahavidyalaya will oversee the implementation of the Memorandum of Understanding.

Any variation or amendment or addition of / to this Understanding shall be mutually agreed to in writing and executed by or on behalf of each of the parties, the MAM and KAHER'S BMK.

This Understanding represents the entire understanding as to the subject matter hereof and supersedes any prior understanding between the parties on the subjects matter hereof.

Maharashtra Arogya Mandal's, Sumatibhai Shah Ayurved Mahavidyalaya is having its principal office at Survey No. 165 A, Malwadi, Hadapsar, Pune – 411 028, Maharashtra, India (herein after called "MAM"), which expression shall, unless it be repugnant to the context or meaning thereof, be deemed to mean and include its nominees, administrators, legal representatives, executors, successors in interest / business, and permitted assignees, of the part one.

AND

And Ayurveda Rasayani (AR) and its associates, located at B-1 Amrutkumbh, Laxmipark Society, Navi Peth, Opp. Hotel Sargam, Pune 411030, India, a research and cancer clinical institution ("Collaborator"). Other Part

Maharashtra Arogya Mandal's, Ayurved Mahavidyalaya and AR shall be individually hereinafter referred to as 'Party' and collectively as 'Parties'.

Whereas

- A. 'MAM " is a NGO with its academic and clinical branches as Ayurveda college and hospital providing wide range of specialty healthcare facilities to Patients.
- 8. 'AR' is engaged in manufacturing specialised Ayurveda based cancer therapies to cancer patients and cancer survivors. These facilities include but are not limited to offering Ayurveda consultation, preparing Ayurveda medicines and dietary supplements for these patients, Panchakarma therapies, offering diet, yoga and psychology consultation.
- C. The parties are interested in exploring possible opportunities of establishing a mutually cooperative and beneficial relationship, including establishing treatment facilities for cancer patients and research.
 - For the purposes of this MOU, "Project" shall mean a collaboration relating to Establishing State of Art Oncology treatment facilities and offering specialized Ayurveda consultation and therapies for cancer patient at the premise of MAM, Hadapsar, Pune.

1. SCOPE OF THE MOU

- 1.1 The Parties will co-operate to:
 - (a) Establish facilities for offering specialized Ayurveda consultation to cancer patients which includes offering Ayurveda, yoga, diet and psychological consultation; preparing personalized medicines and dietary supplements for cancer Patients.

Conduct cancer awareness drives, campaigns and lectures for common public and patients.

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- (c) Conducting various Oncology based training programs for Medical students and professionals.
- (d) Conduct an annual review of current and future Projects approximately one (1) week prior to the anniversary of the execution of this MOU.
- 1.2 Subject to the terms and conditions of any Collaboration Agreement agreed to and executed, each Party will have the right, in any field related to the Project or otherwise, to:
 - (a) conduct business or research independently, whether or not with third parties;
 - (b) continue existing commitments, or make new ones; and
 - (c) Exploit or otherwise take advantage of its intellectual property.

2. TERMS OF MOU

- 2.1 Both the parties agree that this MOU will cover aspects related to patient care and research activities in Ayurveda oncology.
- 2.2 The parties agree that various research activities related to Ayurveda oncology can be undertaken as per applicable research guidelines. The ownership of the intellectual property generated during the project shall be owned by AR only.
- 2.3 Each Collaboration Agreement will include provisions relating amongst other things to:
 - a Project plan pursuant to which the Project will be carried out which will include information pertaining to technical objectives, statement of work, deliverables, schedule, decision gates, resource requirements and costs;
 - (b) funding arrangements for the Project;
 - (c) Holding by the Parties of periodic Project review meetings to assess the management and the progress of the Project and the status of any expenditure;
 - (d) Exploitation of Intellectual property and rights arising from the same including their protection, enforcement and commercialization.
 - (e) Commercial arrangements between the MAM and AR.
 - 2.4 The Parties agree, acknowledge and confirm that for any agreement to be binding on them, it must be in writing and shall be executed by a duly authorized representative of each of the MAM and AR.

2.5 MAM will provide basic infrastructure/facilities required for offering patient TRUE COPY which includes consultation, treatment procedure, inpatient hospitalisation, investigations, dispensing medicines and dietary supplements

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and collecting treatment charges. AR OPD will work exclusively once a week with specialist from Rasayu Cancer Clinic (RCC) offering consultation. IPD Facility if required will be provided by MAM and patient care will be offered as per RCC guidelines and protocol.

- 2.6 AR will make necessary arrangements for offering medical care and consultation by qualified Ayurveda physician trained in RCC Treatment protocol, to patients approaching for treatment in the collaborative AR and MAM OPD. This facility will be initially provided for once a week which can be revised in future based on the need for the project
- 2.7 In case of inpatient hospitalisation MAM will make necessary arrangements to provide necessary medical care, expert consultation and visits by a qualified Ayurveda doctor which will be an employee of MAM or honorary consultant. MAM will also avail expert medical opinion or to refer the patient to appropriate medical facilities in case of any emergencies.
- 2.8 AR will make arrangements to procure medicines as required for the cancer clinic. AR will provide medicines to cancer patients in MAM at a highlysubsidised rate.
- 2.9 AR will offer appropriate training in Ayurveda Oncology to maximum of two Ayurveda Physicians who will be employees of MAM. After the completion of training these physicians will be assessed by senior physicians of RCC. After successful completion of training these doctors will be responsible for providing outdoor consultation as well as inpatient care of cancer patients approaching cancer OPD in absence of RCC Physician. Besides this RCC will also train housemen's/ internee deputed by MAM. The number of such trainees at a given point of time will not exceed six (6).
- 2.10 Both the parties agree to conducting regular awareness activities about the cancer OPD. These activities include Awareness programs, lectures, pamphlets, banners, newspaper articles and Radio broadcast. The expenses of such activities will be borne by either or both the parties which will be decided on case to case basis based on mutual agreement.
- 2.11. AR Will not charge any consultation fees from the patients approaching the OPD in MAM. RCC will provide palliative care therapies aimed to relieve patient symptoms and improve Quality of life in cancer patients. AR will provide medicines in highly subsidised rates.
- 2.12 If required for the betterment of patient, and if the patient is affording advanced therapies patients will be informed about specialised Rasayana therapy and a RCC doctor can refer the patient to RCC headquarter for RUE COPYssary therapies. Refusal by the patient to start specialised Rasayana

therapy will not affect in anyway on patient receiving palliative care therapy at the cancer clinic in MAM.

- 2.13 The responsibility for providing best possible treatment to patient and ensuring his wellbeing lies entirely with the treating physician.
- 2.14 This activity will be a Pilot activity for one year, after which it can be revised as per need.

REPRESENTATIVE

- 3.1 For the term and purposes of this MOU, each party shall appoint a designated representative ("the Representative").
- 3.2 The Representative of the appointing Party will be responsible for:
 - (a) managing, overseeing or coordinating that Party's relationship with the other Party;
 - (b) Identifying any commercial issues that arise between the Parties and refer them to the Competent Authority within the Representative's organization;
 - (c) discussing any issues arising out of this MOU or a Collaboration Agreement with the Representative of the other party; and
 - (d) Co-coordinating the exchange of information between the Parties.
