She added that departmental file work is in process and the documents which are finalized can be uploaded on the website. Dr. Khankhane asked whether we can visit NAAC accredited colleges. On this she replied that visit to Dr. D.Y. Patil college and KLE university is already conducted and SSR of other accredited colleges is already provided to everyone for references. Principal asked to complete work fast so that we can start application process in December.

Agenda No. 17/2022: - To give information about UG & PG Admission Process.

Discussion: As this year inspection was conducted very late hence permission of admission is awaited. Admission process of CET cell has started. UG seat matrix will be published on 16/11/2022. First round list will be displayed on 23/11/2022 and physical verification will be done till 30/11/2022. As government colleges have not received permission yet, admissions might shuffle. No information about admission of PG & Diploma is received. Ph.D. admissions will be conducted in 13 subjects. Recognition for fellowship course is received but admission process is awaited. Out of 100% seats, 85 % are reserved for state quota and 15 % is All India quota. In 85% State quota 15 % institutional quota which will be filled by state government. Out of 70 % seat one seat is reserved for ICCR candidate. Secretary Hon. Mr. Anil Gujar sir said that all admissions will be conducted through competent authority.

Agenda No. 18/2022 : - To transact any business with permission of chair. Discussion :-

 Principal gave information that Mobicom & Speakers are installed in First BAMS classroom. Now for lectures using LCD, teachers can carry only pen drive for lectures. Screen is shifted so that blackboards can be also used.

 He also informed that MUHS inspection for Balrog PG is awaited. Routine NCISM next year inspection may be conducted in Feb. - Mar. 2023. So all data of 2022 should be prepared.

 He gave information about faculty evaluation proforms and asked everyone to keep the document ready from August 21 to July 22. He added that data should be different from annual confidential report.

- 4. Principal gave information about staff selection interview conducted on 30/07/2022 of 18 candidates on temporary basis. Approval is awaited. Staff selection interview of four candidates was conducted on 05/11/2022. Dr. Kaknurkar asked whether vertical reservation is applied? On this principal informed that roster preparation is in process.
- Principal gave information that stock verification of library has started and working of library is closed till 30/11/2022.
- 6. Principal said that attendance of UG & PG students should be increased and for the same compulsion to be done by department. Biometric attendance of students was checked during inspection. He said that first & fourth BAMS are regular batches and two batches are exam going. Fourth BAMS teachers should take efforts to increase their attendance. Teachers should be present during lectures conducted by PG students. Discipline should be maintained. He also informed that many complaints are received about PG hostel and students should maintain discipline properly.
- 7. Principal gave information that it is observed that, teachers does not submit leave application on time also some teachers punch only once. He said that 22 teachers has been identified in the month of Oct. 2022 who have not done punch daily. It will be informed to specific staff & HOD. He added that all the HOD's should see that leave application is submitted by teachers of department in time.
- Dr. Pradhan said that DL is given for BOS meeting of MUHS but is not given for deem university and what about IEC? DL for other colleges. Principal said that he will discuss with Hon. Secretary and policy decision will be taken.
- 9. Dr. Ghorpade requested that age of superannuation should be increased to 64. Hon. Secretary said that age of retirement for nonteaching staff is 60 and institute rules are same for teaching and non teaching staff. Dr. Kore said that for teaching staff total working years are less. Hon. Secretary said that it is not possible for 550 total staff.
- 10. Principal said due to surprise inspection decision about Diwali vacations was pending. Principal thanked Hon. Secretary for granting Diwali vacations. Dr. Nilesh Kulkarni asked for EL to be given to First and Second year teachers. Hon. Secretary said leaves will be granted as per university vacations. Principal said that clinical staff has to work in OPD, IPD during vacations but non clinical and para clinical staff does not have any hospital work during vacations. Decision will be took after discussion with Hon. Secretary.

Discussion:- Dr. Pranita Joshi-Deshmukh gave information about NAAC work done so far. She informed that key indicator 2.2, 2.3, 3.1, 3.2, 4.1, 4.2 & 5.1 is in process. Key indicator 6.1, 6.2, 7.1, 7.2, 8.1 to 8.1.6 documents are ready for uploads.

Google form preparation for IQAC is in process. Teachers database has been updated. Weblink preparation for website is in process. Tabs for the same are ready. Mr. Chandrashekhar Pawar is working on preparing college profile information required for MUHS and NCISM. Working of criteria 2,3 and 5 on department level is going on. Agenda No. 15/2021:- To confirm the proceedings of 36th College Council Meeting held on 03/08/2021.

Discussion: Principal asked if there were any changes in last college council meeting minutes.

Dr. Kore said that changes needed to be done in report of Poshan week.

Principal replied that no information/report was received yet from Dravyaguna department. Dr. Kore replied that there was some technical issue in mailing the report to ssayu@rediffmail.com. Principal said that report can be submitted in writing too. As department of Dravyguna did not submit their report in time, department of swasthavritta submitted their own report separately. With this minutes were confirmed of 36th college council meeting.

Agenda No. 16/2021 :- To give information about M.U.H.S. inspection & Ph.D. Admission.

Discussion: Principal informed that MUHS inspection was conducted on 16/09/2021 for starting Ph.D. course & centre in 9 subjects viz. Swasthavritta, Rasashastra, Agadtantra, Rognidan, Dravyaguna, Shalyatantra, Shalakyatantra, Panchakarma & Streeroga, Application for which was sent on 30/03/2021, visitation followed in September & college received letter of permission in November. Dr. Kaknurkar said that during inspection committee had suggested for a separate library for Ph.D. in each department.

Principal said that the committee appreciated the variety of books in PG department & that Ph.D. section can be added in existing PG library section but with added reference journals.

Principal informed that a total 17 Ph.D. scholars were admitted in 2019-2020 batch in our college. Dr. Kaknurkar asked for the split up. Principal gave the split up as follows- 3 students in Samhita, 5 students in Rachana Sharir, 3 Students in Kayachikitsa & 6 students in Kriya Sharir were admitted.

Dr. Kaknurkar asked why 3 Ph.D. scholars had to be shifted from our college. Principal replied that Dr. Tongaonkar is due to retire in next two months. Dr. Sachinkumar Patil said that MUHS circular states that PG/Ph.D. guide should not be alloted students if he/she is going to retire.

Dr. Kaknurkar then wanted to know about fees for Ph.D. students. Dr. Kalaskar replied that it was approx. Rs. 58000/- including college & university fees for newly admitted Ph.D. scholars.

Principal then informed regarding upcoming MUHS inspection which shall be Impact based assessment and according to guidelines proposed by NAAC. All departments should furnish respective departmental information.

Dr. Kore asked whether information should be for last one year. Principal replied that revised guidelines are awaited but according to the manual information for last 5 years should be kept ready. All departments should ensure that all records viz. UG/PG musters, library record, dead stock etc. with information regarding procedures in clinical departments should be updated. He said that departments should provide information till November end by 15/12/2021 & information for the month of December by 05/01/2022. Secretary then told that NABH renewal inspection shall be conducted so respective data should be kept ready & updated.

Agenda No. 17/2021: - To discuss about MUHS Summer 2021 examination, CAP and about Winter 2021 examination.

Discussion :-

Principal gave information that discussion on Winter 2020 theory exam of I, II & III BAMS was already done in the previous meeting but exam of students who were Covid-19 positive & appearing for Winter 2020 exam was conducted from 30/07/2021 to 17/08/2021. Summer 2021 exams was conducted in stepwise manner as per schedule by MUHS. Pre MD examination was conducted on 18 & 20/08/2021 while final MD examination took place on 18, 20, 22 & 25/08/2021. Viva/Practical examination of Pre MD was on 08/09/2021 while final MD exam was on 09 & 13/09/2021. Theory examination of III BAMS (2010) & IV BAMS (2012) was conducted from 21/09/2021 to 10/10/2021 while viva/practical examination was conducted from 11/10/2021 to 26/10/2021.

Central Assessment Program (CAP) for Summer 2021 exam commenced from 20/10/2021 & envelops, bundles handed to university on 09/11/2021. Dr. Ramesh Ujwale worked as custodian & Dr. Vikram Supugade worked as assistant custodian.

Agenda No. 18/2021: - To give information about NAAC.

Discussion: - Dr. Pranita Joshi - Deshmukh gave information that Impact assessment shall be for 900 marks. IQAC has finalized a format regarding monthly report. NAAC committee

has been revised. Soon a formal meeting will be conducted & we will solicit information according to each criteria. Data submitted till 2019 end is ok.

Principal said that Whats App group of criteria incharge has been formed for NAAC related communication. This should speed up the pending work & help in communication. NAAC work has been hampered for last 7-8 months due to Covid pandemic. Now each criteria team should revise their submitted data & information as a meeting shall be conducted soon.

Secretary added that now according to new rules NAAC is mandatory regarding receiving scholarship fees of students. Hence if no NAAC then no fees shall be received henceforth We have to complete NAAC by next 2 to 3 months. Fix an earliest date for NAAC meeting. Principal then fixed the meeting to be conducted on 03/12/2021 at 2.30pm.

Agenda No. 19/2021: - To give information about forthcoming UG & PG Admission.

Discussion: Principal informed that AIAPGET 2021 was conducted & result was out in October. NEET UG was conducted in September & result was out on 1st November. UG cut off marks for open category is 138 & that for PG is 103.

There is no clarity yet regarding the UG & PG admissions. Dr. Kaknurkar asked whether BAMS course shall be of one & half years? Secretary replied in affirmative that it is likely.

Agenda No. 20/2021 : - To transact any business with permission of chair. Discussion :-

1) PG coordinator Dr. Anand Kalaskar reminded all HOD's regarding a notice by MUHS dated 10/11/2021 & college notice reiterating the same dated 15/11/2021. He asked all HOD's to ensure their PG students punch, both while incoming & out going from college. Also to ensure that PG students sign their musters kept outside office as well as in respective department too. PG students should always wear aprons, ID card & a nameplate while in college premises. Now on, HOD's should submit a report to office by 5th of every month stating the monthly presenty/ of their PG students after comprehensively checking for their muster signs in office records as well as departmental records.


Secretary asked Dr. Pravin Bhat to complete accounting work regarding Shalakya CME & send finalized account to CA for audit in next 8 days.

He also asked him regarding the update of MOU with H.V. Desai . Dr. Bhat said he is in touch with Mr. Umesh Pawar . Secretary asked him to take follow up.

2) Dr. Pravin Bhat gave information about six days CME organized by Shalakya department during 20/09/2021 to 25/09/2021. Total 30 participants participated in the CME from all over India. Dr. Bhat provided information of facilities provided to participants regarding stay & food. He also gave sessionwise information of CME. For the CME teaching faculty & PG students of Shalakyatantra department have worked as organizing committee members. Principal congratulated all Shalakya department faculties & PG students for their active participation in said CME.

3) The Principal informed that from 03/11/2021, vaccination has been stopped in library premises which has been fully restored from 08/11/2021.

4) The internal exam for 1st & IVth BAMS shall commence from 30/11/2021. They are to appear for MUHS exams from 31/01/2022. All concerned teachers to ensure that



practicals, dissections, case-taking should be completed & journals checked in forthcoming days.

- 5)Dr. Kaknurkar asked whether next session shall resume for exam appeared students. Principal said that the results & notice is awaited from MUHS.
- 6) Dr. Nilesh Kulkarni requested to be allowed 11 more EL for all non-clinical subjects as they were working in May this year. Principal replied that as MUHS had not declared Summer vacations in May it is not possible. As Diwali vacation was declared by MUHS the administration allotted 15 days vacation to all teachers.
- 7)Dr. Nilesh Kulkarni further said that current attendance register for both UG & PG are not adequate & they should be at least 125 pages.

Principal said that henceforth we shall consider this keeping in mind the 1.5 years academic batch.

8)Dr. Kulkarni asked regarding the status of Ph.D. synopsis submission & IEC.

Principal said that it is in process & decision shall be taken in next few days.

9)Dr. Nilesh Kulkarni asked about conduction of MET.

Dr. Kore replied that a meeting of MET committee was conducted and it has been decided to conduct it in 2nd & 3rd week of February.

10)Secretary then informed that current year Dr. Dada Gujar puraskar was awarded to Ravi Bapatle & Dr. Ashok Belkhode for their social work.

Felicitation program shall be conducted in January or February as per convenience of the chief guest.

- 11)Everyone should update office regarding their vaccination status.Dr. Kaknurar asked whether it is mandatory to get vaccinated. Secretary replied in affirmative.
- 12)Secretary said that everyone should compulsory carry their ID cards henceforth, also said that NAAC work should be hastened.
- 13)Dr. Kaknurkar asked about PG students wearing scrub. Should they wear apron too? Principal said that apron should be worn over the scrub.

Principal thanked Secretary that no late marks were counted & no leaves were deducted in Covid pandemic but from 01/12/2021 late marks will be counted.

- 14)Principal then informed that Secretary has asked to all Professors & Readers to use & sit in their PG departments. Dr. Kaknurkar said that PG departments are empty & lonely. Is it mandatory to sit there? Secretary replied in affirmative, also said that you can sit in UG departments when you have work there only, also when you have lectures, practicals & departmental work you can sit in UG departments.
- 15)Principal then informed that OPD duty in central lab on Sunday shall henceforth not be applicable for Rognidan department. While HOD's of Shalakyatantra & Panchakarma should come and discuss regarding starting of Sunday duties in their respective OPD's.
