Institutional Distinctiveness

Social and tribal development is distinctive priority of Institute.

Health Sector work was extended in the field of Water conservation and potable water availability as it was the root cause of health problems in Hadapsar vicinity. The graph of such activities is elevated continuously by efforts of Maharashtra Arogya Mandal team.

Education facilities are limited in the Bhimashankar tribal area for girls. Hence, tribal people are not sending girls to school after 4th Std. To decrease the dropout number of girl students, we are running Mukhtangan Tribal Girls hostel at Narodi, Tal. Ambegaon, Dist. Pune since 1988. Currently we have 70 girls in our hostel who are taking education, lodging, boarding and all related things which needs for education from 5th to 10th free of cost.

Mega Squint surgical Camp was also organized in December 2015 where 167 Patients were benefitted. The event was mentioned in the 'India Book of Records', 'Asia Book of records' and 'Limca Book of Records'.

Maharashtra Arogya Mandal and Bharat Forge limited is working in 12 tribal villages having focus on Livelihood (Increase in Family Income), Infrastructure, Water for Drinking & Agriculture, Health & Hygiene, Education, Environment. Also organized health check-up camps of Takoradi, Pune & Kotamdara, Ambegaon where total no of beneficiaries were 323.

In Sane Guruji Arogya Kendra, Hadapsar free prosthetic Hand replacement camp (LN.4) was organized by MAM in collaboration with Rotary Club of Pune Sarasbaug and Rotary Club of Pune Downtown. 873 total patients benefitted up till date.

In Sane Gurji Arogya Kendra, Hadapsar Camp for Jaipur Foot measurement was organized in collaboration with Rotary Club of Pune, Downtown and Rotary Club of Kolhapur Midtown. Total 262 patients were benefitted up till date.

Health Check up Camp was organized at Mukhtangan Narodi. 80 students benefitted from this camp. School Health Check up Camp was arranged at Thakarwadi & the total 300 students were benefitted from this camp.

In 2015, during Swine flu endemic, Institute distributed Guduchyadi Kwath Herbal Immunity Booster Medicine. 23000 Volunteers and patients were benefitted.

Cervical and breast cancer screening was conducted at places like Gujar Snehavardhini at new Sangvi, Ghongavali, Narudi, Vastigriha and Yavat, Hadapsar with 1193 beneficiaries. HPV vaccine drive conducted for prevention in young female students of age 9 to 13 at Sane Guruji School, SSAM at various areas of Pune city 2650 beneficiaries were benefitted. Faculties from SSAM actively participated in this activity.

Varkari checking and medicine distribution were done at Saswad and 1322 beneficiaries were benefitted. Our institute also participated in flood affected area at Tasgaon, Ankolhopand, Bhilandi and 618 affected people were checked and given medical aid free of cost.

Disease wise free camp like Hernia, squint camp, Osteo Arthritis camp, Gout, are conducted & needy are given free surgeries and treatment. Active participation of School, college teachers & students with staff of MAM participated in organ donation Campaign rally.

Medical and ICU Equipments, Oxygen Plant installation and Huge Solar panel system for energy savings are some of the hospital developments.
