Sir/Madam,

- 1) This is with reference to your first appeal vide ref. no. MAM/SS/Ayu/447 dated 26.09.2025 filed by The Principal, Maharashtra Arogya Mandal's Sumati Bhai Shah Ayurved Mahavidyalaya (Inst. ID-AYU0148) to the Commission against the order passed by the President, MARBISM vide letter of even no. dated 01.07.2025 with regards to issuance of permission in PG courses for the Academic year 2025-26.

Further, on verification of the submitted appeal following conclusion has been drawn: -

- 2) In view of the above submissions of the college, the Chairman, NCISM decided to consider the appeal filed by the The Principal, Maharashtra Arogya Mandal's Sumati Bhai Shah Ayurved Mahavidyalaya (Inst. ID-AYU0148) against the impugned order dated 14.08.2025 passed by the MARB-ISM.
- 3) Further, a letter vide Ref. No. 51-39/2025-26/Comm. Appeal/College (Ayu.) dated 26.09.2025 has been received from the Commission, NCISM directing the President, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine, NCISM to grant permission to Maharashtra Arogya Mandal's Sumati Bhai Shah Ayurved Mahavidyalaya in prasuti tantra department 02 pg diploma seats instead of 01 Pg diploma seats under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 for the academic session 2025-26 as per the available teacher student ratio.
- 4) Therefore, extended permission is granted Grant of Yearly Permission to Maharashtra Arogya Mandal's Sumati Bhai Shah Ayurved Mahavidyalaya, Sr.No.165 A, Malwadi Hadapsar, Distt. Pune-411028, Maharashtra (Inst. ID-AYU0148) with an intake capacity of 60 seats in UG (BAMS) course and 80 seats in 13 PG courses in the subject namely (1) Ayurved Samhita, Sanskrit & siddhanta-06 seats (2) Kriya sharir-06 seats (3) Rasa Shastra & Bhasajya kalpana-06 seats (4) Dravyaguna Vigyana-06 seats (5) Rog Nidan avum Vikriti vigyan-06 seats (6) Agad Tantra avum Vidhi vaidyaka-06 seats (7) Swasthviritta-06 seats (8) Prasuti & stri roga-08 seats (06 seats + 2PGD) (9) Kaumarbhritya-06 seats (10) Kayachikitsa-06 seats (11) Shalya tantra-06 seats (12) Shalaky

tantra-06 seats (opted for Shalakyana-Netra Roga Chikitsa-03 seats and Shalakyana- Karna, Mukha & Nasa Roga Chikitsa-03 seats) (13) Panchakarma-06 seats under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 for the academic session 2025-26-reg. and relevant regulations thereunder in respect of appeal dated 26.09.2025 .

- (i) Minimum **15% of undergraduate seats of the permitted with an intake capacity of 60 seats in UG (BAMS) course and 80 seats in 13 PG courses** shall be treated as all India quota. The counseling for seats under all India quota shall be conducted by respective counseling authority as designated by Central Government for A.Y. 2024-25 and counseling for the remaining 85% seats or as the case may be, shall be conducted by the concerned Counseling Authority of that State/UT. **The permission of the college stands withdrawn if the college fails to comply with the aforesaid direction of the Central Government/NCISM for all India quota or the students admitted thereunder.**
- 5) Admissions made in violation of the above conditions will be treated as invalid and action will be initiated under NCISM Act & Regulations there under.
- 6) Further, **as per Sub-section (7) of Section 29 of NCISM Act, 2020**, The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine may conduct evaluation and assessment of any University or medical institution at any time, either directly or through any other expert, having integrity and experience in medical profession, without any prior notice and assess and evaluate the performance, standards and benchmarks of such University or medical institution and if the college is found to be not maintaining the Minimum Essential standards as specified in the concerned Acts & Regulations then in **accordance of Section 28 (1) (f) of NCISM Act, 2020 the issued permission of the college shall deemed to be withdrawn and denial of permission shall be issued by MARBISM for stoppage of admission for that particular academic year or the subsequent year.**
- 7) Discrepancies, if any, may be immediately brought to the notice of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine, NCISM.
- 8) **Compliance of all the requirements of Aadhaar Enabled Biometric Attendance System as mentioned in the Implementation letters vide. ref. no. 3/2024/MARB/AEBAS & HMS. Dated 09.05.2024 & 06.09.2024 issued by the Board.**
- 9) **The following requirements should be fulfilled by the college by 31<sup>st</sup> December 2025 and compliance report should be submitted to MARB-ISM, in order to be considered for the grant of permission for the academic session 2025-26 as per rules:**
- All the requirements under the provisions of the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant Regulations made thereunder should be fulfilled,
  - All the requirements of Minimum Standard of infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in NCISM (Minimum essential standards, assessment and rating for undergraduate Ayurveda colleges and attached teaching hospitals) Regulations, 2024,
  - All the requirements of Minimum Essential Standards, Assessment and Rating for Postgraduate Institutions and Minimum Standards for Postgraduate Education in Ayurveda, Regulations, 2024,
  - All the requirements of the National Commission for Indian System of Medicine (Minimum Standards of Undergraduate Ayurveda Education) Regulations-2022.
- 10) **The fulfillment of the conditions given above may be made within the time period specified and compliance report should be submitted by the college to President, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine. The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine will verify that the conditions have been fulfilled for considering the permission for the academic session 2026-27.**
