Kaumar Panchakarma

In the hospital panchakarma procedures snehana, swedana, basti, jivha pratisarana, nasya are recommended in this age group. Being growing age group Abhyanga, shalishashtika pinda sweda, yapana basti also prescribed for growth and development.

After examination in Balroga OPD patients come in Panchakarma OPD. In Panchakarma OPD again systemic examinations are done for deciding indications and contraindications of panchakarma. If patient is indicated then consent is taken before the procedure. Doctors explain the panchakarma procedures to patient's relatives.

The patient going in Panchakarma OPD is further managed by the Panchakarma therapists along with PG students.

Special training sessions are taken in our institute towards educations of panchakarma procedures in paediatric patients on for PG and Fellowship students. The training session is taken by Senior Professors and Lecturers every year.
